### Understand Math

- Count change together
- Identify shapes in your house
- Follow a recipe to practice fractions
- Count the steps, windows, etc. in your home
- Build something together to practice measurement
- Do a number search/play a license plate game
- Ask your child's teacher to help you identify problem areas
- Practice with your child every night
- Get a tutor if necessary

- Bake a pumpkin pie
- Take a nature walk together

- Test whether objects will sink or float
- Make homemade bubbles
- Fill a variety of containers with water to explore volume and measurement
- Explore the states of matter by making root beer floats
- Take a nature walk and identify animal tracks, trees, and leaves

- Discuss what your child learned in school each day
- Go over assignments before your child turns the work in
- Study for upcoming tests together
- Contact your child's teacher if your child is having difficulty with homework; let him/her know if your child finds the assignments too hard or too easy
